



## MILSET YOUNG SCIENTISTS AWARD

### Introduction

As specified in the MILSET ESI Standards, the target age group for MILSET Expo-Sciences International is from 13 to 25 years old.

However, MILSET encourages the participation of children, including a special program for 9 to 12 year old students attending ESI. In some countries, these students are participating in activities called "*Les Petits Débrouillards*" or "*Pandillas Cientificas*".

The MILSET Young Scientists Award is presented during the MILSET Expo-Sciences International, to a delegation composed either of 9-12 year old participants or to a delegation that includes that age group.

### Criteria

- The organisation must be a MILSET member.
- The organisation has never received this award.
- The organisation is not hosting the event.

### Qualities

The jury bases its decision on the observed behaviour of the participants, supervisors and delegation leader. In particular, the jury focuses on qualities such as:

- Exemplary behaviour;
- Interactivity and communication with the public and participants of others delegations;
- Innovation in the presentation of their projects or special activities organised by the delegation.

### Awards

- The organisation receives a trophy and a certificate at the MILSET Expo-Sciences International Closing Ceremony.

### Procedures

- A jury of three (3) persons chaired by a MILSET Executive Committee Member.
- Approval by the MILSET Executive Committee.
